## TONIGHT'S MUSICIANS

**David Peralta** is a native of San Sebastian de Los Reyes, Venezuela. He began studying viola at the age of 13, following the El Sistema method established by Dr. Jose Antonio Abreu. (El Sistema is a music education program that promotes human opportunity and development for youth through free music instruction.) At age 18, David studied at the Simon Bolivar Conservatory and Unearthe. Upon winning an audition contest, David joined the Simon Bolivar Orchestra and has toured throughout the world, playing in Salzburg, Luzerne, the United Arab Emirates, London, Spain, Chicago, Los Angeles, Boston, and New York City's Carnegie Hall.

At present, David serves as the Music Minister at the Knight's Creek Church in Scio, NY, where he offers music instruction to students of all ages. In partnering with The Fountain Arts Center in Belmont, NY, David's students have joined with other local musicians to establish an orchestra, and have performed concerts in Almond, Houghton, Wellsville, Belmont, Scio, and Avoca.

Throughout each step in the rhythm of his life, each note that shapes the melody of his music, David offers all the glory and thanks back to God: *Soli Deo Gloria!*

**Andrea Peralta** is David's daughter. She began her studies with violin at age 6 and viola at age 12. In 2019, she won the Youth National Orchestra Chair in the viola section. This is her first year as a student at Wellsville Central School, and she has been selected to perform with the NYS Zone 15 Area All State String Orchestra in November. She also performs regularly with the Fountain Arts Center Orchestra.

**Amanda Robbins** is a pianist, church musician, homeschooling mom, farmer, and teacher, to name a few of the hats she wears. She graduated from Houghton College with an undergraduate degree in Music Education and a graduate degree in Music. The most enjoyable music making experiences are shared with others, and to that end, she is blessed to collaborate with David tonight, as well as perform with the Genesee Valley Chorus, Quintet Six, and the Fountain Arts Center Orchestra.
